## A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

Let us continue to pray for our nation and all of our elected officials. We trust in the Lord and know that He is in charge and holds all things in His hands.

I handed over a lot of information in my Note from the Pastor last week so I just want to rehash that a bit and go deeper. Sherry Waddell has pointed out that there are three paths in the life of faith and we need to walk down each of them. They are not meant to be separate but intertwined. However, at times they do separate and so it is helpful to speak of each of them and then explain how they should weave together.

The first is the sacramental path. For Catholics, this journey in the normal course of life can involve baptism as a baby, First Communion and First Confession around the age of 7, and Confirmation around the age of 13 or so. Then later on in the process of discernment, one might feel called to married life and receive the sacrament of marriage or the priesthood and be ordained. Finally, as one faces life's challenges and the reality of our mortality, you might receive the Anointing of the Sick, perhaps more than once. This is the sacramental path. It gives us sanctifying grace, which brings us into friendship with Christ or what we call a state of grace and sustains our path to the Father and salvation.

The second is the path of stewardship. This is where recognizing the many gifts that God has given to each of us, we find ways to give back in terms of our time, talent, and treasure. Often we find ways to serve in the life of the parish and help the parish

continue to live and grow.

The third is the path of personal relationship with Jesus Christ. This one can be often forgotten because we often think if someone has received the sacraments and is involved in the life of the Church, they have made a decision for Christ and seek to grow in that relationship each day. That simply is not true. The Gospel or Good News must be presented so that it can be believed. And once believed, we must grow in that relationship and become fruitful and missionary disciples. This third path is critical and part of the emphasis of this Clear Path of Discipleship.

These are all meant to be bound together. As we move through the sacraments, we should be deepening our relationship with Christ and recognizing how He calls us to be a gift to Him and others. At times we can fail to present the Gospel and invite people to faith. This is part of the reason for creating this Clear Path of Discipleship so that no matter where we are on the sacramental and stewardship paths, we would also grow in relationship to Christ.

As I mentioned before, here are the thresholds on this path to personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

**Trust:** A person has a positive association with Jesus or an individual Catholic and may begin asking questions out of passive curiosity.

**Openness:** A person admits to a general need or desire for personal spiritual change. This is not the same as a commitment to specific changes.

**Seeking:** A person moves from being passive to actively seeking to know the God who is calling him or her. The seeker is

engaged in a spiritual quest.

**Decision:** The decision, in faith, to follow Jesus as an obedient disciple in the midst of the Church, which brings about new life.

**Beginning Disciple:** A person has committed to following Jesus by turning away from sin, and makes any sacrifice in order to personally grow, and lives habits of the Christian life.

**Missionary Disciple:** A person has decided to personally answer the call to take part in the mission of the Church by sharing the Good News.

**Fruitful Disciple:** A person is fully equipped for lifelong Catholic mission and makes any sacrifice to help another person to grow spiritually.

One way to deepen our understanding of this is to ponder some of our friends, family members, or acquaintances and assess where they might be on this list of thresholds. Perhaps they are not even there because they are in a place of pre-trust. Or perhaps they have made a decision for Christ but they are not Catholic. That might be then a question more of an openness and seeking about communion with the Catholic Church, which faces certain thresholds as well.

I will share more about this next week. I will be back on Thursday evening from Chicago, God willing. While the time away is enjoyable, it is always good to come back home.
