Dear Friends in Christ,

I am departing this week to Chicago once more for a priest conference. I will be away from February 3 to the 13th. While I am away, Fr. Mauricio Hurtado will be covering for me on the weekend of February 8 and 9. We were in the seminary together at St. Patrick's for a couple years before he was ordained and I went off to study elsewhere. He is a priest I much respect and is also the new Vocation Director for the Diocese. If you are not familiar, a Vocation Director helps young men and women discern their vocations.

During the week, there will not be regular Daily Mass or Confession. There will still be early morning Adoration and Adoration all day Thursday and Adoration on Tuesday evenings from 5 to 6 PM. I will still be "on duty" so to speak

from Chicago so the work of the parish continues even as I won't be physically present. Obviously, we have an excellent staff and many volunteers that keep likeness. We are also our brother's so much of what we do humming. It makes it actually a lot easier for me to go and not worry.

Foundations of Faith starts this week! I hope you have been leaning into the prayer and fasting. And thinking about who you might invite. I have been doing my own inviting this last week.

Lastly, I think it is wise to reaffirm the at times uncomfortable but fundamental truth about the dignity of the human person. It applies to us all! We are all made in God's image and likeness. How important whether we consider the tragedy of abortion or the current extreme levels of anti-immigrant rhetoric or the promotion of euthanasia

or the death penalty or the way we regard the homeless and mentally ill. We are all made in God's image and keeper. And they are not a burden to us but a gift, as we are a gift to them. I encourage you to keep your eyes on Christ and avoid the dehumanizing nature of our current societal discourse that leaves one group of people or another behind. This is not of Christ.


Teen Day of Recollection: February 22




